

An Act to incorporate the Town of Ocean City, on Tybee Island in Chatham County; to grant certain powers and privileges to the same, and for other purposes:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Georgia, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That ~~all~~ all persons, citizens of the State of Georgia, who are property owners on that portion of Tybee Island hereinafter more particularly mentioned, are hereby declared and created a body politic and corporate, and such incorporation shall be known as the Town of Ocean City; it shall have a common seal; may sue and be sued in any court of law or equity in this State; may purchase, hold, possess, enjoy and retain to them and their successors in perpetuity, or for any term of years, any estate, real, personal or mixed; make by-laws and govern itself by such ordinances, resolutions and by-laws, for municipal purposes, as it may deem proper, not in conflict with its Charter, the statute laws of the State of Georgia, or of the United States; may acquire by gift, act, purchase or otherwise, such real and personal property as may be deemed necessary for corporate purposes, and to use, manage, improve, sell, convey, rent or lease any or all of such property in such manner and upon such terms as may be deemed most advisable for the corporate interests.

Sec II. Be it further enacted, That the corporate limits of said town shall embrace all that portion of Tybee Island east of the Western boundary
